ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER  
86-1

WHEREAS Idaho Supreme Court has adopted guidelines for the prompt disposition of all categories of cases in the courts in the State; and

Whereas unnecessary delay in the processing of cases adversely affects the quality of justice provided the citizens of this State; and

WHEREAS the Court has not only the ability but also the duty to supervise the work of the court and the cases which come before it; and

WHEREAS there are delays in the criminal case processing system caused by the delay between the Magistrate Judge binding felony defendants over to the District Court and the arraignment of those defendants in the District Court;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, That the Magistrate Judges of the Third Judicial District shall include as a part of their order binding the defendant over to the District Court, the date, time and location of the arraignment of the defendant before the District Court.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, That a copy of said order shall be served upon the defendant or defense counsel upon entry of the order.
