

**WHEREAS**, the existing State of Emergency in the United States and State of Idaho due to the public health and safety threat posed by the novel coronavirus (COVID-19) has forced the Owyhee County Sheriff to limit the number of inmates in the Owyhee County Jail, it is,

**ORDERED** that, as of the date of this Order, any person with an outstanding order from a district judge or magistrate judge directing a person to complete a certain number of days in the Owyhee County Jail or in the custody of the Owyhee County Sheriff between the date of this Order and May 31, 2020 shall have an additional sixty (60) days to complete such time after the Owyhee County Jail resumes accepting new inmates, unless the judge who issued the order determines otherwise, and it is further,

**ORDERED** that any person subject to this Order shall contact the Owyhee County Jail (208-495-1154, ext. 102), to determine when to report to complete the ordered jail time.
