IT IS ORDERED that, in accordance with the provisions of Idaho Court Administrative Rule #38, the clerks of the district courts of the counties of Adams, Canyon, Gem, Owyhee, Payette and Washington may dispose of all civil records of proceedings completed in their respective counties during the period January 1, 1978 to December 21, 1979 by complying with the provisions of Civil Records Disposition Directive dated January 10, 1984; that all exhibits presented to the court in such cases and not re-claimed may be disposed of after a 30 day notice to the record owner or attorney who submitted such exhibits to the court; that all clerks complete a Records Disposition Form as civil records are disposed of, retaining one copy for their files and forwarding one copy to the Trial Court Administrator.
