
ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
86-7

WHEREAS THE IDAHO SUPREME COURT has promulgated case processing time standards for the Idaho court system,

AND WHEREAS the delay occasioned by cases remaining on the court calendars without action diminishes the quality of justice and creates additional cost to both the litigants and the court,

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that monthly dismissal calendars be established in each county within the Third Judicial District. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Trial Court Administrator establish a schedule of dates and times for the dismissal calendars consistent with the Motion Day calendars in each county.
