Whereas the Legislature has established the Crime
Victims' Compensation Account, and

Whereas the provisions of Idaho Code Section 72-1025
specifies the cases in which a fine shall be imposed and the
payment deposited in the Crime Victims' Compensation Account,

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AND THIS DOES ORDER,
That the Clerks of the District Court of the Third Judicial
District shall apply the first ten dollars (\$10.00) of the fine
imposed for each conviction of a misdemeanor that does not
involve motor vehicles, including misdemeanors prosecuted under
the provisions of Section 18-8004, and the first twenty dollars
(\$20.00) of the fine imposed for the conviction of any felony to
the Crime Victims' Compensation Account, unless the judge
imposing sentence makes a specific finding that : 1) the
defendant is indigent and unable to pay and therefore waives the
imposition of the fine, or 2) specifically orders the payment of
the Crime Victims' Compensation fine in addition to any other
fine imposed.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, That the provisions of this
Administrative Order shall apply to those cases in which the
crime for which the defendant has been convicted occurred on or
after July 1, 1986.
