
WHEREAS, I.C.A.R. 48(a) provides: “In the event of an emergency or threatened emergency, the Administrative Director of the Courts or his or her designee, or where practicable, after consultation with the Administrative Director of the Courts or his or her designee, the administrative judge, or his or her designee if the administrative judge is unavailable, may order the closure of a district court and related offices, including the district court clerk’s office, until the safe operations of the court and its offices can be restored;” and

WHEREAS, pursuant to I.C.A.R. 48(b), “‘Emergency or threatened emergency’ includes, but is not limited to, any occurrence or threatened occurrence, whether natural, man-made, or technological, that causes or threatens to cause: . . . (2) an interruption in the performance of court operations A technological occurrence constituting an emergency includes any failure or disruption of the court management system or other court technology that causes or threatens to cause an interruption in the performance of court operations;” and

WHEREAS, the undersigned, after consultation with the Administrative Director of the Courts, has determined that, on this date, there is a disruption in the operation of the court management system or other court technology that has interrupted the performance of court operations in Canyon County and the disruption is sufficiently severe that it may last for more than one day; it is,

HEREBY ORDERED that the Canyon County district and magistrate courts, and related offices, including the Canyon district court clerk’s office, are closed for the remainder of the day on January 30, 2019 and until such time as safe and efficient operation of the court management system can be restored. In the event the court management system can be restored to full operation, the Canyon County courts will reopen for normal business hours and operations on January 31, 2019, or such abbreviate hours as may be warranted.
