**WHEREAS**, between March 18, 2020 and March 24, 2020, the undersigned entered certain administrative orders in response to the emergency created by the spread of the COVID-19 virus in Idaho and the Third Judicial District; and


**WHEREAS**, on March 26, 2020, the Idaho Supreme Court entered its Order "In Re: Emergency Reduction in Court Services and Limitation of Access to Court Facilities," which superseded the above-referenced administrative orders entered by the undersigned; and

**WHEREAS**, the undersigned has determined that certain of the above-referenced administrative orders are not in conflict with the Idaho Supreme Court's Order "In Re: Emergency Reduction in Court Services and Limitation of Access to Court Facilities" it is

**ORDERED** that, effective March 24, 2020, any person with an outstanding order from the court directing that person to serve a certain number of days in the Owyhee County Jail or in the custody of the Owyhee County Sheriff between March 24, 2020 and May 31, 2020 shall have an additional sixty (60) days to complete such service, after the Owyhee County Jail resumes accepting new inmates, unless the judge who issued the order determines otherwise, and it is further,

**ORDERED** that any person subject to this Order shall contact the Owyhee County Jail (208-495-1154, ext. 102), to determine when to report to complete the court-ordered jail time.
