**WHEREAS**, on September 10, 2020, the Idaho Supreme Court issued its ORDER RE: COMMENCEMENT OF JURY TRIALS which, authorizes the resumption of criminal jury trials<sup>1</sup> in the courts of the State of Idaho commencing September 14, 2020, subject to certain exceptions; and

**WHEREAS**, the Idaho Supreme Court's October 8, 2020 AMENDED ORDER IN RE; JURY TRIALS provides that the September 10, 2020 ORDER remains in full force and effect, shall be construed in conjunction with the October 8, 2020 AMENDED ORDER, and "any orders suspending jury trials in accordance with" the September 10, 2020 ORDER "shall be deemed to have tolled the time utilized to calculate the right to a speedy trial pursuant to" Idaho Code section 19-3501; and

**WHEREAS**, the September 10, 2020 ORDER provides that criminal jury trials may not commence in a county "anytime during a calendar week" if the "Administrative District Judge has determined on the Thursday prior to commencement of a trial that" the county in which a prospective juror has been summoned to attend court has a seven-day moving average incidence rate of confirmed or presumed cases of COVID-19 that is either:

1. 25.0 or greater per 100,000 population; OR
2. Between 14.0 and 24.9 per 100,000 population with an upward or increasing trend from the prior Thursday


as reflected on the Cases by County page of the Idaho Department of Health and Welfare's COVID-19 Data Dashboard, available at [www.coronavirus.idaho.gov](http://www.coronavirus.idaho.gov); and

**WHEREAS**, after consulting the above resources, as updated at the close of business on Thursday, October 29, 2020 the undersigned has determined that the following counties in the Third Judicial District have seven-day moving average incidence rates of confirmed or presumed cases of COVID-19 that preclude the commencement of jury trials the week of November 2, 2020:

1. Adams County: 103.1 (over 25.0)
2. Canyon County: 34.1 (over 25.0)
3. Owyhee County: 21.8 against a rate of 21.7 on October 22, 2020 (upward)
4. Payette County: 27.4 (over 25.0)
5. Washington County: 51.9 (over 25.0)

**IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that no jury trial shall commence in the counties of Adams, Canyon, Owyhee, Payette, or Washington during the week of November 2, 2020.
